SUPERINTENDENT PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

The superintendent shall keep himself informed of modern educational thought and practices by study, by visiting other school systems, by attendance at educational conferences, and by such other means as may appear to be appropriate.

ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNEL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

The administrators of the district shall be encouraged to stay abreast of the latest trends and methods in education including the attainment of higher education degrees.

- 1. Principals and other administrators maybe directed by the superintendent to attend conferences, workshops, and other activities which will directly benefit the Rumson schools. Expenses of travel fees, tuition, board and room, and other incidental expenses will be paid by the district.
- 2. Principals and other administrators shall be expected to attend national meetings of the National Association of Elementary School Principals, Association of Supervision and Curriculum Development, and other organizations on a scheduled basis approved by the superintendent and the board in accordance with money budgeted for that purpose.
- 3. Administrators shall be required to attend periodic inservice workshops sponsored by the district to improve skills in personnel management, supervision and improvement of instruction, and other aspects of school management.
