## **NEPOTISM**

Persons related by blood or marriage to a board member may be employed in this school district but the interested board member must abstain from any vote affecting the related employee.

Persons related by blood or marriage to a member of the administrative staff shall not be appointed to a position subject to the supervision of that staff member.

This shall not apply to any person within such relationships who has been regularly employed by the board prior to the inception of the relationship, the adoption of this policy, or a board member's election.

It is the intent of this policy to avoid any situation where there can arise the appearance of a conflict of interest either on the part of a member of the board or a member of the administrative staff.
