ASSIGNMENT; TRANSFER

The superintendent shall make certified staff assignments in the manner best calculated, in his/her judgment, to enhance the educational program.

Teaching, supervisory and administrative personnel are subject to transfer after recommendation of the superintendent and approval by the board of education by means of a roll call vote. Procedures for such transfers shall comply with provision of current negotiated agreements and state and federal law. Particular attention shall be paid to ensuring that there shall be equivalence of teachers and administrative staff among the schools.
