ADMINISTRATIVE RULES

The board of education shall delegate to the superintendent of schools the function of specifying required actions and designing the detailed arrangements under which the schools will be operated. Such rules and detailed arrangements shall constitute the administrative regulations governing the schools.

These administrative rules and regulations must be consistent with board contracts and policies, New Jersey statutes, rulings of the Commissioner and the courts and rules of the State Board of Education.

Administrative rules shall be reviewed by the board at the same time that the policy is presented for adoption. The board shall exercise its right to review and veto administrative rules should they, in the board's judgment, be inconsistent with policies adopted by the board.

Such rules and regulations shall serve as guides for action for district employees and shall be adhered to until the board changes or rescinds any such rule or regulations following its presentation at a public meeting of the board. The board itself shall adopt administrative regulations when specific state laws require board adoption, and may do so when the superintendent recommends revisions to deal with the matter in the future.
