SUSPENSION OF POLICY

The boar of education has developed a careful and deliberate process of formulating and adopting the policies by which it governs the district. Requests for suspension of any existing policy should receive the same careful consideration.

Therefore:

- 1. Any request for a waiver of policy shall be considered in light of the policy itself, in addition to the particular circumstances of the moment.
- 2. The board shall decide whether the policy still reflects the considered intent of the board. If it does, the suspension will be denied and the policy re-affirmed in the minutes.
- 3. If the policy does not reflect the intent of the board, then that policy shall become the board's prime policy priority.

In the event of an emergency requiring immediate action, the superintendent shall have the power to waive policy in the single instance. In such cases, the superintendent shall report the instance to the board president immediately, and request reconsideration of the policy at the next regular meeting.
