EXECUTIVE SESSIONS

The board reserves the right to meet privately in executive session to discuss issues exempted by law from public sessions. The board will exclude the public from any meeting to discuss such matters only when it first adopts a resolution at a meeting to which the public will be admitted:

- 1. Stating the general nature of the subject to be discussed, and
- 2. Stating as precisely as possible, the time when and circumstances under which the discussion conducted in closed session can be disclosed to the public.
