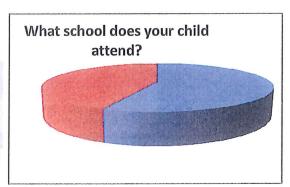

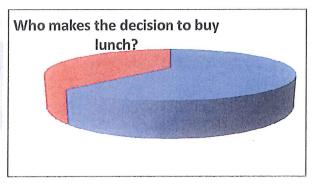
What school does your child attend?

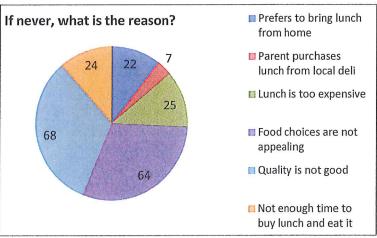

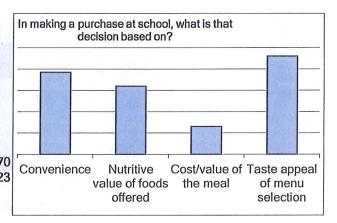

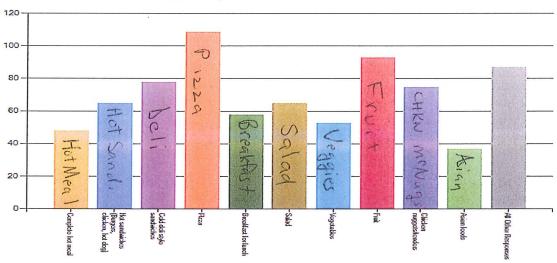

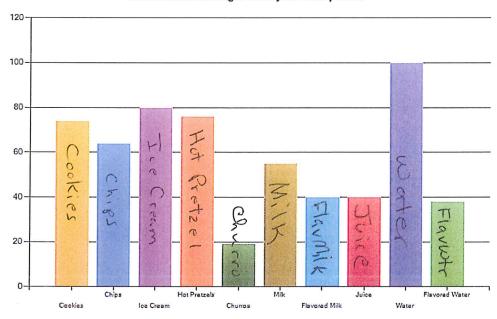
