AS AN ART TEACHER OF 10 YEARS, AND A PROFESSIONAL WELL VERSED IN EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH, MY GOAL IS FOR MY STUDENTS TO ENJOY AND INVEST IN THE TIME SPENT ACTUALLY CREATING SOMETHING, WITHOUT A JUDGEMENTAL ATTACHMENT TO THE FINISHED PRODUCT.


