# Art Club (Grades 5-8)

Art club this year will provide students with the opportunity to express themselves freely in the form of an open studio session. The advisor will act as a facilitator to student expression and creativity. With a focus on mixed media work, students in art club this year will learn to use multiple types of materials to create a piece of artwork.
